

Terms of participation

The Second Bohdan Osadchuk Polish-Ukrainian-German School. 22th - 30th November 2015

Organizer: Jan-Nowak Jeziorański College of Eastern Europe in Wrocław (Kolegium Europy Wschodniej im. Jana Nowaka-Jeziorańskiego we Wrocławiu), German Culture Forum for Eastern Europe in Potsdam (Deutsches Kulturforum östliches Europa) and Regional Centre of International Debate in Wrocław (Regionalny Ośrodek Debaty Międzynarodowej we Wrocławiu). I. Conditions of participation

1. The School offers a series of lectures, seminars, tutorials and workshops in the form of the 7-day School.
2. The participants are required to take part in all forms of activities offered by the Organizer.
3. English is the language of instruction. The participants are required to have a fairly fluent command of English which is sufficient to communicate with others and understand lectures with ease.

II. Payments

1. The School's Organizer provides the participants with accommodation, food, teaching materials, entry tickets and local logistic.
2. The Organizer does not reimburse any travel costs to Wrocław borne by the participants. The Organizer might take into consideration reimbursement of arrival costs in full or in part when deemed necessary.

III. Documents and eligibility

1. The School is designed for students from Germany, Poland and Ukraine.

2. Recruitment requirements:

a. candidates from **Germany** and **Poland** are required to complete the electronic questionnaire on the following website: www.kew.org.pl by **30th October** 2015.

b. due to visa proceedings candidates from **Ukraine** are required to complete the electronic questionnaire on the following website: www.kew.org.pl by **16th October** 2014 (the short recruitment period due to the fact that the Organizer shall send the official invitation to each successful candidate from Ukraine).

3. Candidates are required to provide the Organizer with a CV and a passport photo.

IV. Admission Committee

1. The Admission Committee decides on successful candidates by 4th November 2015.
2. The candidates will be notified on the admission via an e-mail.
3. A formal invitation will be sent to successful Ukrainian candidates via an e-mail (a formal visa requirement).

V. The school schedule

1. The participants are expected to arrive to Wrocław on 22th November 2015. Classes begin on 23th November 2015. The School ends on 28th November 2015.

2. The organizers can change the dates of the School or even cancel entire event for reasons beyond force majeure.
